



Striking earthquake in L'Aquila – Rotarians start reconstruction

Since April 7 Rotary District 2090 had already distributed and pitched 250 ridge tents received from the RC Grésivaudan of Grenoble (France) and assembled a feeding camp.

The critical period of the emergency has been overcome and Rotarians have the courage and resourcefulness to again bounce back.

Therefore, the Clubs of the Districts of Italy, Albania, Malta and San Marino are planning to rebuild the University of L'Aquila, investing a sum of € 13,000,000.00 (thirteen millions) in a three year period (equivalent to yearly € 100.00 per Rotarian).

As you might know, since 1596 a good part of the economy of L'Aquila was based on its University and you might have heard that many students have been victims of the earthquake. This project has been chosen as a service to the culture and to the sciences.
